Our Literature Depot is still open - but has had to make a few adjustments about picking up literature because of Covid-19:

To avoid risks of contamination - Covid-19 guidelines of handling literature/product is vigilantly used to keep everyone as safe as possible. Orders will be placed in a plastic bag or a box, depending on the size of the order. At this time there is no contact when picking up orders - I have loved one's with serious health issues and immune deficiencies (not covid related), so have quarantined myself from virtually any outside contact so I'm able to be there for them as needed.

Placing orders are as usual: email me what you need and the quantity.

I'll email a reply with the total, include a copy of the sales order slip for your records along with my home address. (Which by the way is Central Tacoma)

We'll confirm a pick up day and time frame.

Orders are now picked up at my home with the original order slip included.

There is now a container (blue recycle bin) directly outside the front door for pick-ups.

Blank envelopes are provided to place payments (checks only at this time please).

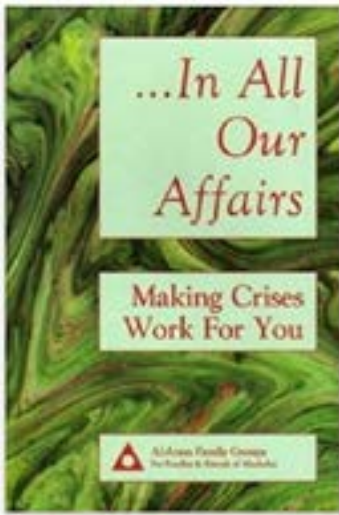

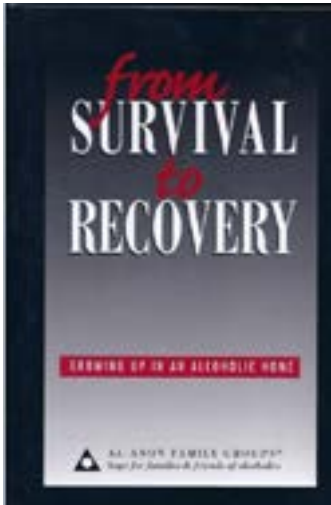

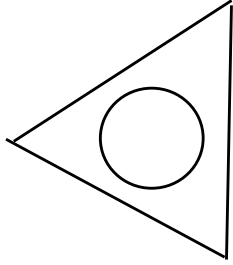

ELECTRONIC MEETING BEST PRACTICES

Some meetings are specific to Men, Women or LBGTQ+. We ask that you honor their Group conscience by not attending a meeting that you would not choose to attend in person.

* When you sign in, type in your first name only to protect your anonymity.

Beware: If you call in to a video conference, your phone number is displayed for all to see.

Be sure you are in a private space so that people who are not in Al-Anon don't see or hear the meeting.

If you want to be visible to others you'll need to call in with a smart phone or a computer that has a camera. Or you can choose to not allow video and just use the audio option. Mute yourself when you're not talking - whether you are in a telephone or video meeting. To mute yourself in video meetings, hover over the meeting with your cursor or touch the screen with your finger and it will show you the options at the bottom, top, or side of the screen, depending on your device. You can mute/unmute, have video or no video. If you joined by phone, use *6 to mute/unmute.

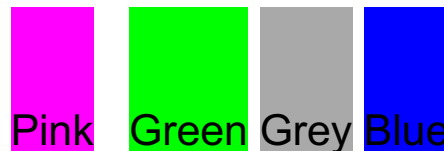

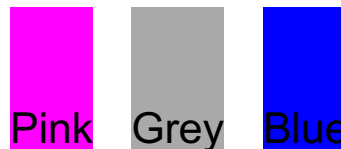
